

Instructions for downloading on the computer: Import GPS data on the Komoot website

We recommend that you upload the GPS data online to your navigation app on your PC before you travel, so that you can use it on site on your smartphone or other GPS-enabled device.

If you want to download the data directly on your mobile phone – see page 4.

Tip: if you don't have a navigation app installed yet: The Komoot app is a good option here.

The app is free of charge when installed. However, as soon as you start the navigation, "Start trial" must be selected. From the 7th day onwards, this is subject to a fee (as of April 2026: € 4.99 per week or € 59.99 per year). The subscription can be cancelled at any time!

Our GPS data can be uploaded online from your computer to the Komoot website, or another navigation app. This document will give you instructions on what steps you need to follow on your computer/laptop:

1. Download GPX files from the Donau Touristik customer portal

Check all the boxes on the left, then click. "DOWNLOAD BUCHUNG/BOOKING" or click on all the arrows pointing down to start the download. The files will appear on your computer in the Downloads folder.

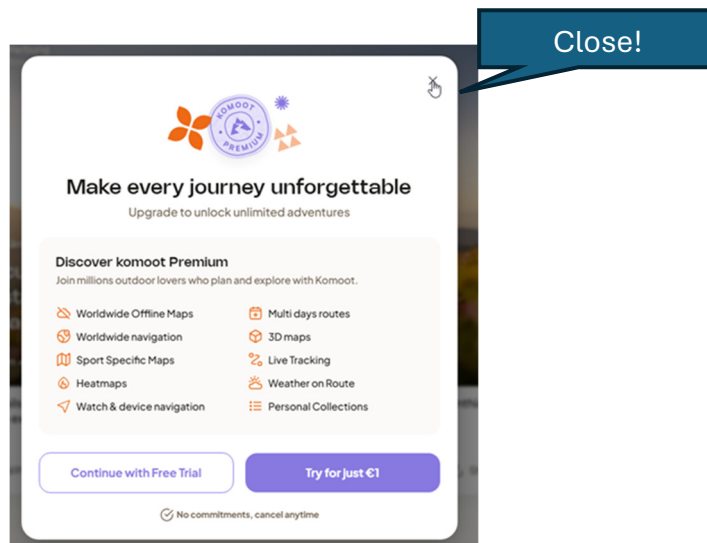

3. Register on the Komoot website

To do this, click on the "Register now" button in the top right corner.

The page in Figure 2 opens. To register, you need an E-mail address, an Apple ID or Facebook access.

As long as you don't want to navigate, but only want to import data, you can simply close the query after the trial version or subscription **by clicking X** in the to continue.



4. Import GPS data

"Click" on the NEW symbol in the top right corner
-> "**Import GPS data**" selection .

A new page will open
(see Figure 4).

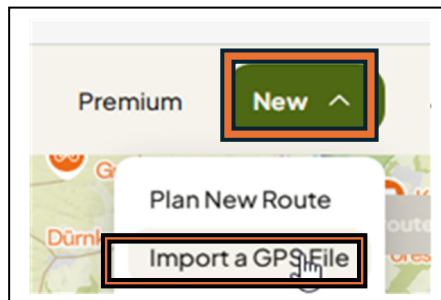


Fig. 3 to 4. – Import GPS data



"Click" on the "**Upload file**" button. Then select the desired file from your download folder on your computer.

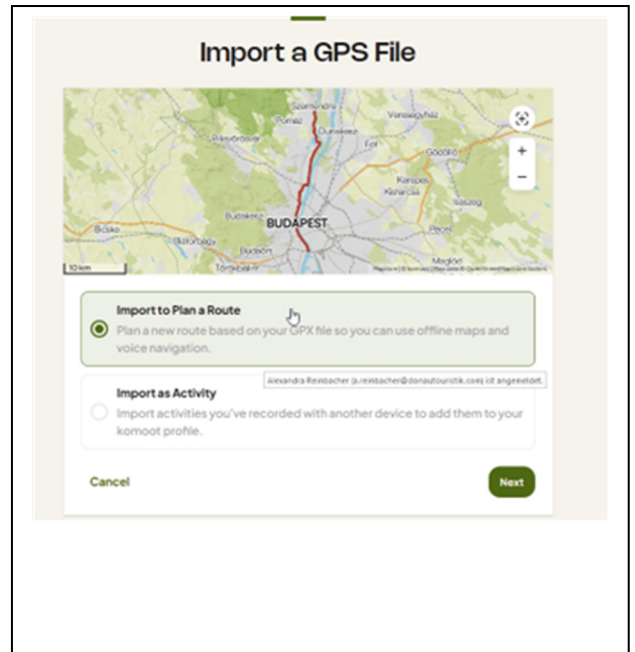


Fig. 5: to 4 – Import GPS data

Once you've imported a file, select the "**Import as Scheduled Tour**" option (see Figure 5).

In the next window -> Selection **Sport "Bicycle"**
and in the next window -> selection: **"Follow the original route"**. Then "click" on **"Save Tour"**.

A new window will open where you can name your tour. The import of the file is completed "by clicking on **Done**".

You can now find the tours you have just imported on the Komoot website in the Komoot app under the **Menu item "Saved"**.

Once you have uploaded all the data, you can use the files using the Komoot app or another GPS-enabled device on your smartphone.

In the Komoot app, you can find the tours you have just imported under the menu item -> **Profile -> Saved Tours**. If you want to start the bike tour, select the desired stage in the saved tours. Click on "Start navigation".
Attention: As soon as you want to navigate, you have to decide on the free trial version or a subscription in the Komoot app.

Instructions for your mobile phone/smartphone: Import GPS data into the Komoot app

Our GPS data can also be uploaded directly to the smartphone in the Android or iOS app of Komoot (sometimes for a fee!) or to another navigation app.

This document will give you instructions on which steps you need to follow on your smartphone.

Tip: if you don't have a navigation app installed yet: The Komoot app is a good option here.

1. Download GPX files from the Donau Touristik customer portal

Check all the boxes on the left, then click. "DOWNLOAD BUCHUNG/BOOKING" or click on all the arrows pointing downwards.

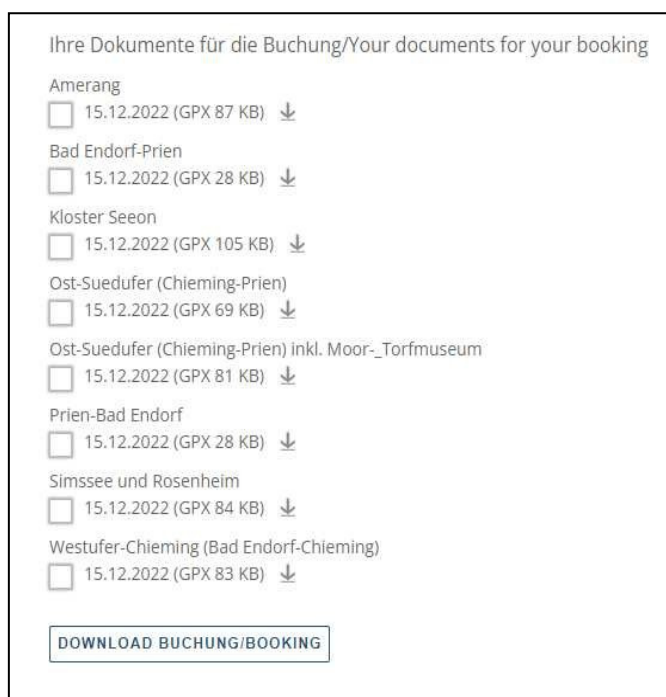
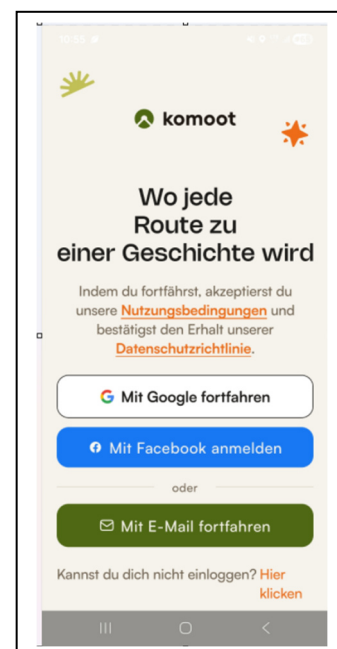


Fig. 1: to 1. – Download GPS data

Note: The GPS data will be downloaded as a ZIP folder when you "click" on the rectangles. In your downloads folder, click on the ZIP folder to extract the data. Only then can you import them into the app.

2. Download the Komoot app free of charge from the "Play Store" for Android devices and from the "App Store" for Apple devices

3. Register in the app

Here you have the option to register with "Continue with Google", with "Facebook" or with "Continue with email address". Fig. 2: to 3. – Register the app

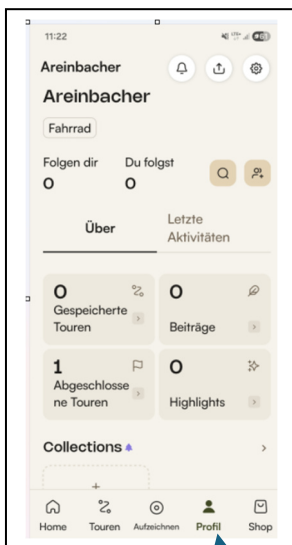
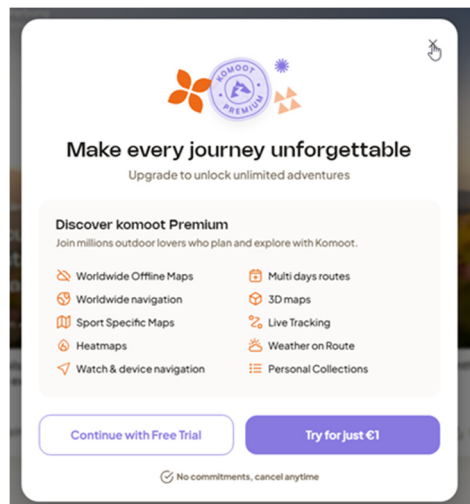


Fig. 3: to 4. GPS data

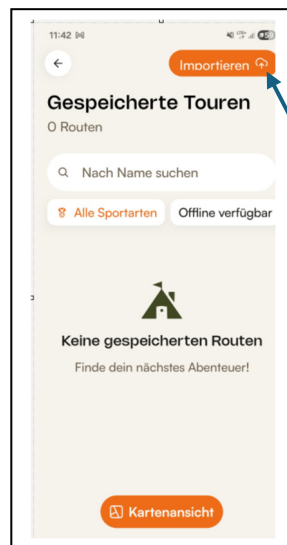


Fig. 3.1: 4. GPS data

4. Import GPS data in the Komoot app (if not already done via the computer)

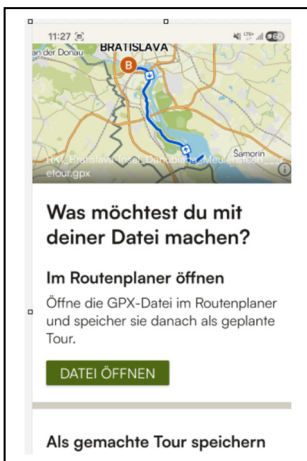
Select the "Profile" in the bottom bar.

Menu item "Saved Tours" and then click on "Import".

Select "Import files (GPX, FIT, or TCX)". You can then select the desired file from your download folder and import the file into the app.

Alternatively, open the Downloads folder on your phone, click the file you want to share, and select Share. Then select the app and the file will be imported into the app.

Once you've imported a file, select the "Open File" option – see Figure 4.



In the next window: Select "Save".
The window opens

Figure 5. Here you can enter the name for the tour. **It is important** that you tick "Save for offline navigation" and before you save

You can now find the tours you have just imported in the app under the menu item -> **Profile -> Saved Tours**. See Figure 3.
