

Instructions for your computer: Import GPS-files into Komoot online

We recommend that you upload the GPS data online to your PC before you travel and then use it on site on your smartphone via komoot app (partly chargeable) or GPS-enabled device.

Our GPS data can be uploaded online from your computer to the Komoot website. This document gives you instructions on the steps you need to take on your computer/laptop:

1. Download GPX files from the Donautouristik customer portal

Click on all arrows pointing to the bottom to start downloading the GPS-files to your computer. The files are displayed in the download folder on your computer.

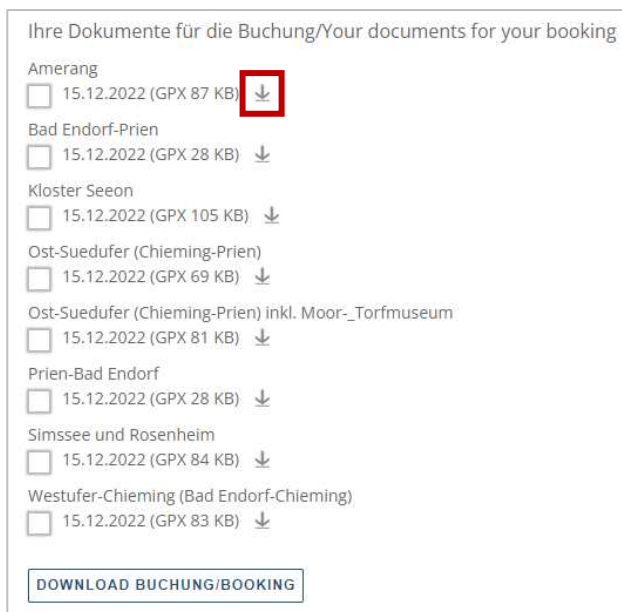


Fig. 1: to 1. – Download GPS-files

3. Register on the homepage

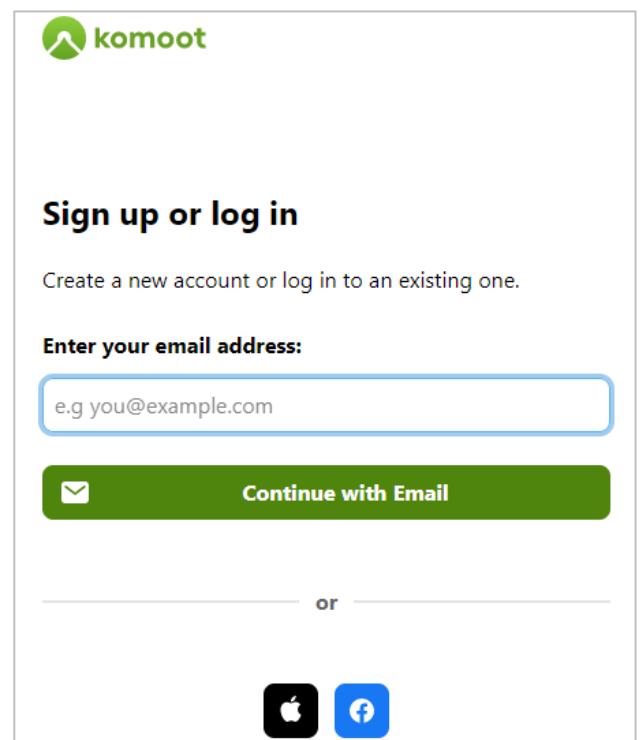


Fig. 2: to 3. – Registration

To do so, click on the button "Sign up or log in" in the upper right corner. The page in figure 2 opens. To register, you need an email address, an Apple ID or a Facebook login.

2. Open Komoot website

4. Import GPX-files

Click on the plus icon at the top right corner and select "Import GPS file" from the options. A page will open (see Figure 4) where you can then upload the data.

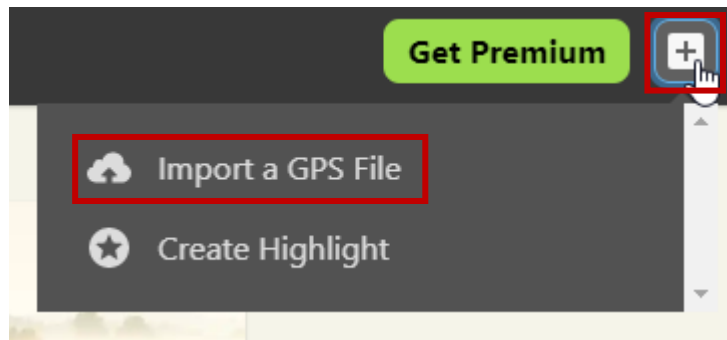


Fig. 3: to 4. – Import GPX-files

In the next window select the discipline "Bike Touring" and in the next window select the option "Stick to original route". Then click on "Save tour".

A window will open where you can name your tour. The import of the file is completed by clicking on "Got it!".

You will find the just imported tour on the homepage under the menu item "Tours" and "Planned".

Once you have uploaded all the files, you can use the Komoot app on your mobile phone or another GPS-enabled device to use the files on your bike ride. If you want to start a tour, select the desired tour from the planned tours. Click on "Start Navigation" and start your next adventure on two wheels!

Click on the "Upload file" button. Then select the desired file from your download folder on your computer.

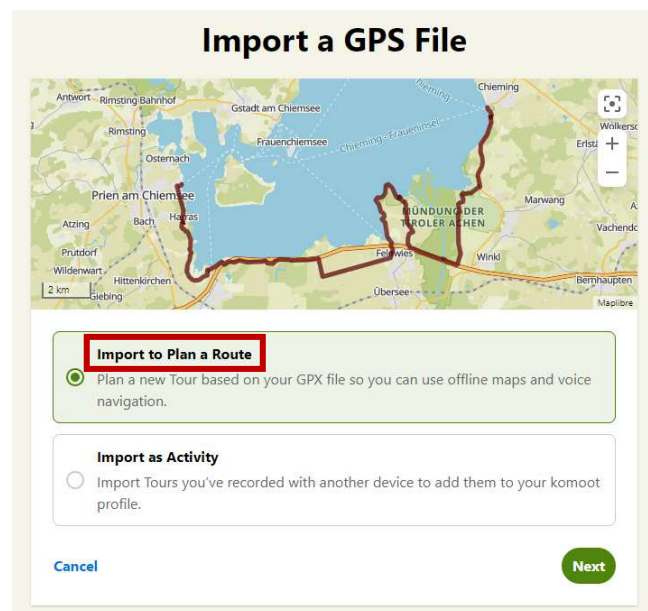


Fig. 5: to 4. – Import GPX-files

Once you have imported a file, select the "Import to Plan a Route" option (see figure 5).

Instructions for your smartphone: Import GPS-files into Komoot app

Our GPS data can be uploaded to the Komoot Android or iOS app (partly chargeable) on your smartphone. This document gives you instructions on which step you need to take on your smartphone:

1. Download GPX files from the Donau Touristik customer portal

Select all rectangles on the left and then click on "DOWNLOAD BUCHUNG/BOOKING" or click on all arrows pointing to the bottom.

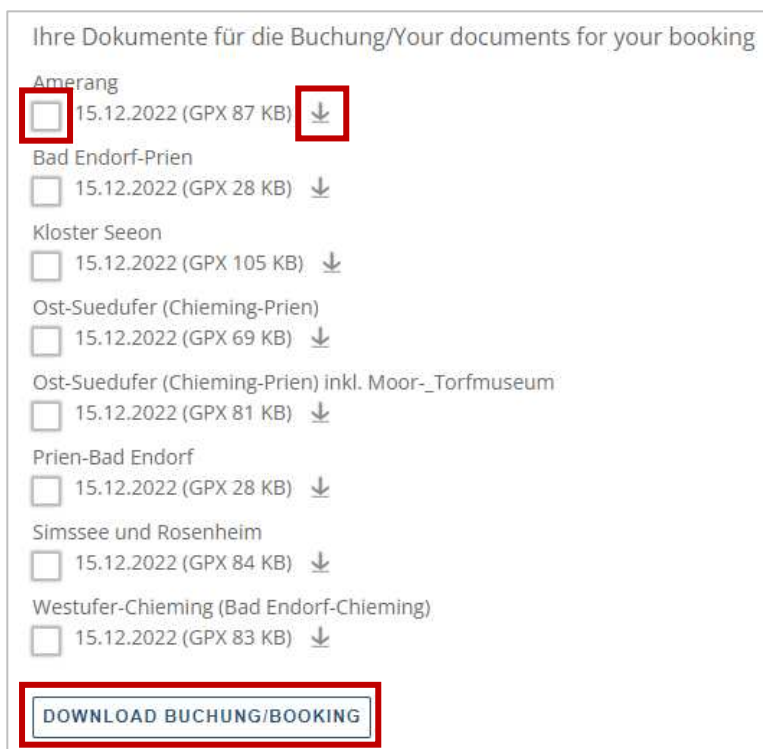


Fig. 1: to 1. – Download GPS-files

2. Download Komoot app for free from the "Play Store" for Android devices and from the "App Store" for Apple devices

3. Register in the App

To do this, you need an email address, an Apple ID, or a Facebook account.

Note

The GPS files are downloaded as a ZIP folder when clicking on the rectangles. Click on the ZIP folder in your download folder to extract the data. Only then can you import the files into the app.

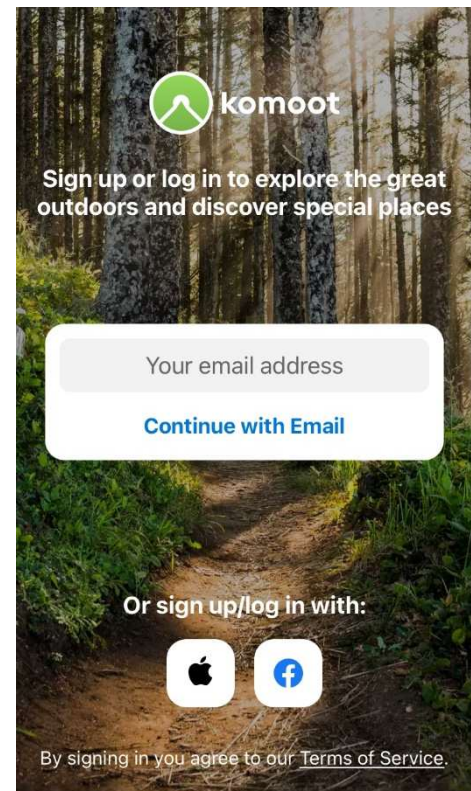


Fig. 2: to 3. – App registration

4. Import GPS files into the Komoot App

Select "Profile" in the dark grey bar at the bottom. Click on the plus icon and select "Import file (GPX, FIT or TCX)" from the options. You can then select the desired file from your download folder and the file will be imported into the app.

Alternatively, open the download folder on your phone, click on the file you want and select "share". Then select the Komoot app and the file will be imported into the app.

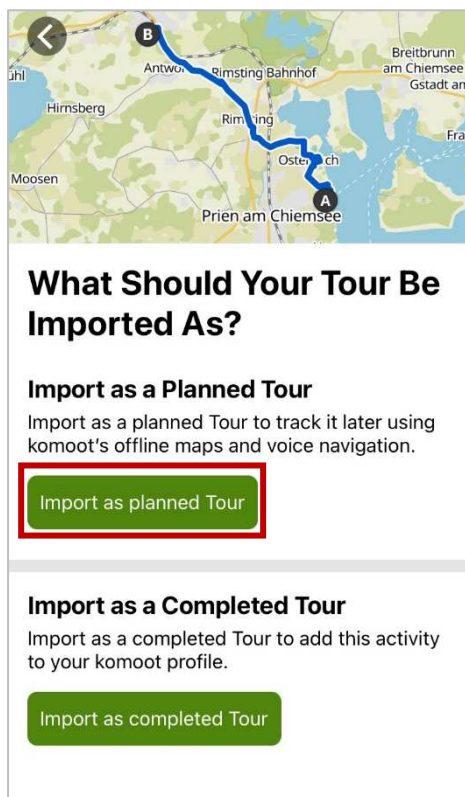


Fig. 4: to 4. – import data

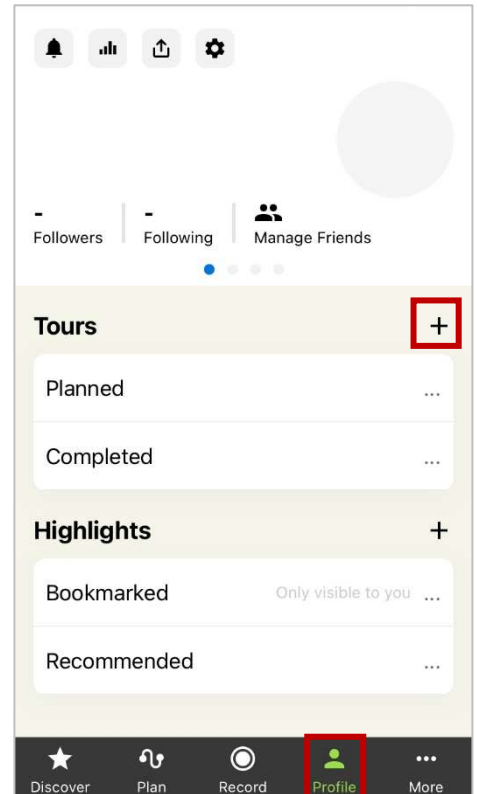


Fig. 3: to 4. – import GPS-files

You can now find the newly imported tour in the app under the menu item "Profile" under "Tours" and "Planned" (see figure 3).

If you want to start the tour, select the desired tour from the planned tours. Click on "Start Navigation" and start your next adventure on two wheels!

Once you have imported a file, select the "Import and Schedule" option (see figure 4). In the next window, select the sport "Bike Touring".

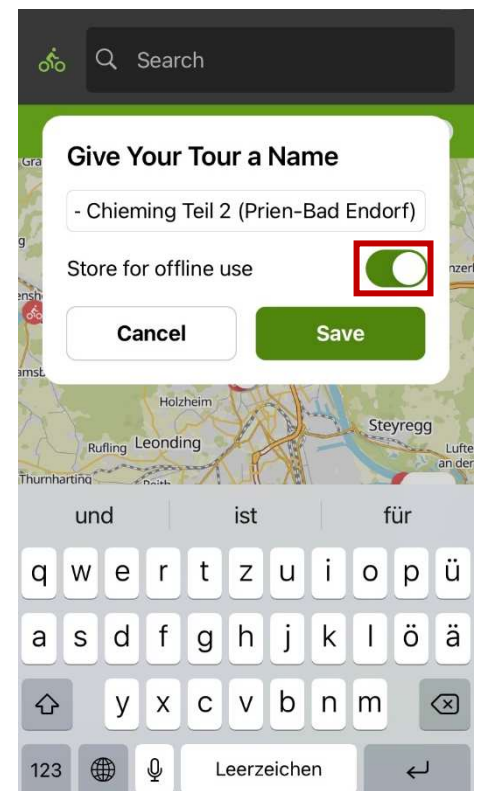


Fig. 5: to 4. – save data

In the next window, tap "Save". The window opens as shown in figure 5. Here you can enter a name for the tour. It is important that you check the icon on the right of "Save Offline". Then click on "Save" again.
